There are so many events happening tomorrow evening (Tuesday Nov 12th). Take your pick from:

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
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

Member engagement & Assemblies – idea brainstorm

We were trying to think of ways to increase membership commitment/involvement & getting people to continue to think about what they can contribute, build connections between members. Some ideas from the brainstorm:

- Skill-share directory
- monthly potluck dinner/brunch
- increased social media presence – youtube channel? vine/instagram?
- Throw a party!
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- Cake for all the members whose birthday was that month?
- Private FB group for members so we can share updates about internal stuff via social media
- Featuring a member & telling their story via email on a regular basis
- Events that are less social-focused and more bakery-focused... like classes or work days? Similar to Central Park Strawberry Festival or SEEDS events
- Send something out during Holiday Season to wholesale customers – things that are upcoming for the next year?
- Strawberry jam-making in April? promote it in early March...

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- Assemblies
- Kitchen Table Conversations – round-table discussions with a scribe. Maybe have two of those before the assembly?
